Discussion, Pampering, Cooking and Craft days. We meet every Wednesday morning. Please call WWILD for more information.

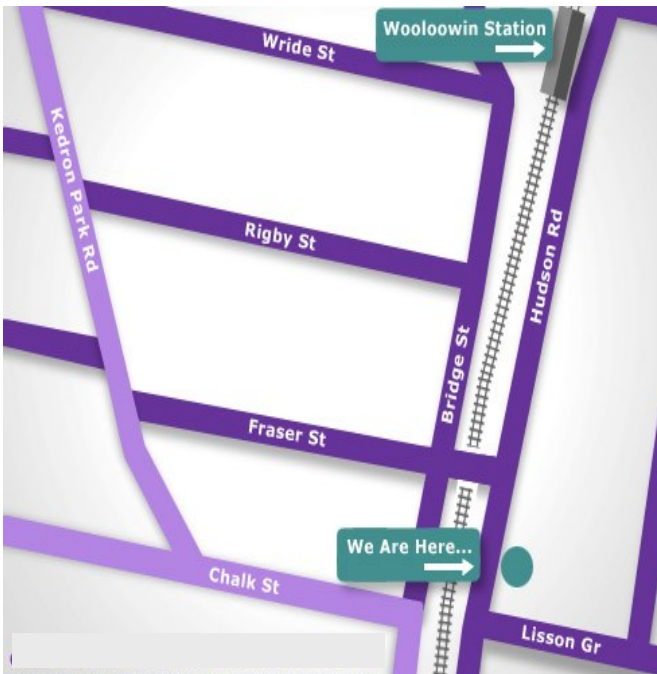
How to get to WWILD?
