# What is the Disability Royal Commission (DRC)?

The Royal Commission into Violence, Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation of People with Disability (also called the Disability Royal Commission or DRC) started in 2019 and goes until September 2023.

The DRC knows that people with disability experience high rates of violence and abuse.

The DRC want to hear stories from people with disabilities and their supporters about what has happened and what needs to change.

The DRC will tell the government how to stop abuse against people with a disability.

You can tell your story to the DRC – by telephone, in an email, on an online form, in a private session, or by attending a public hearing.
